ANTICIPATED LENGTH OF REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Veronica should be involved in an extensive habilitation program throughout her developmental years (through age 21), and it is anticipated that she will require total care through life expectancy.

VOCATIONAL HANDICAPS

Profuse neurological damage has left Veronica with severe restrictions, limitations, and deficits in every sphere including cognitive, motoric, auditory, visual and behavioral/social. I anticipate she will be dependent upon caregivers for all of her daily needs throughout her life expectancy.

IMPACT ON PLACEMENT AND RANGE OF JOB ALTERNATIVES

Severe. Veronica's physical and cognitive limitations prevent placement in the labor market and virtually eliminate any and all job alternatives.

PRE-ACCIDENT VOCATIONAL ALTERNATIVES
BY OPTION
